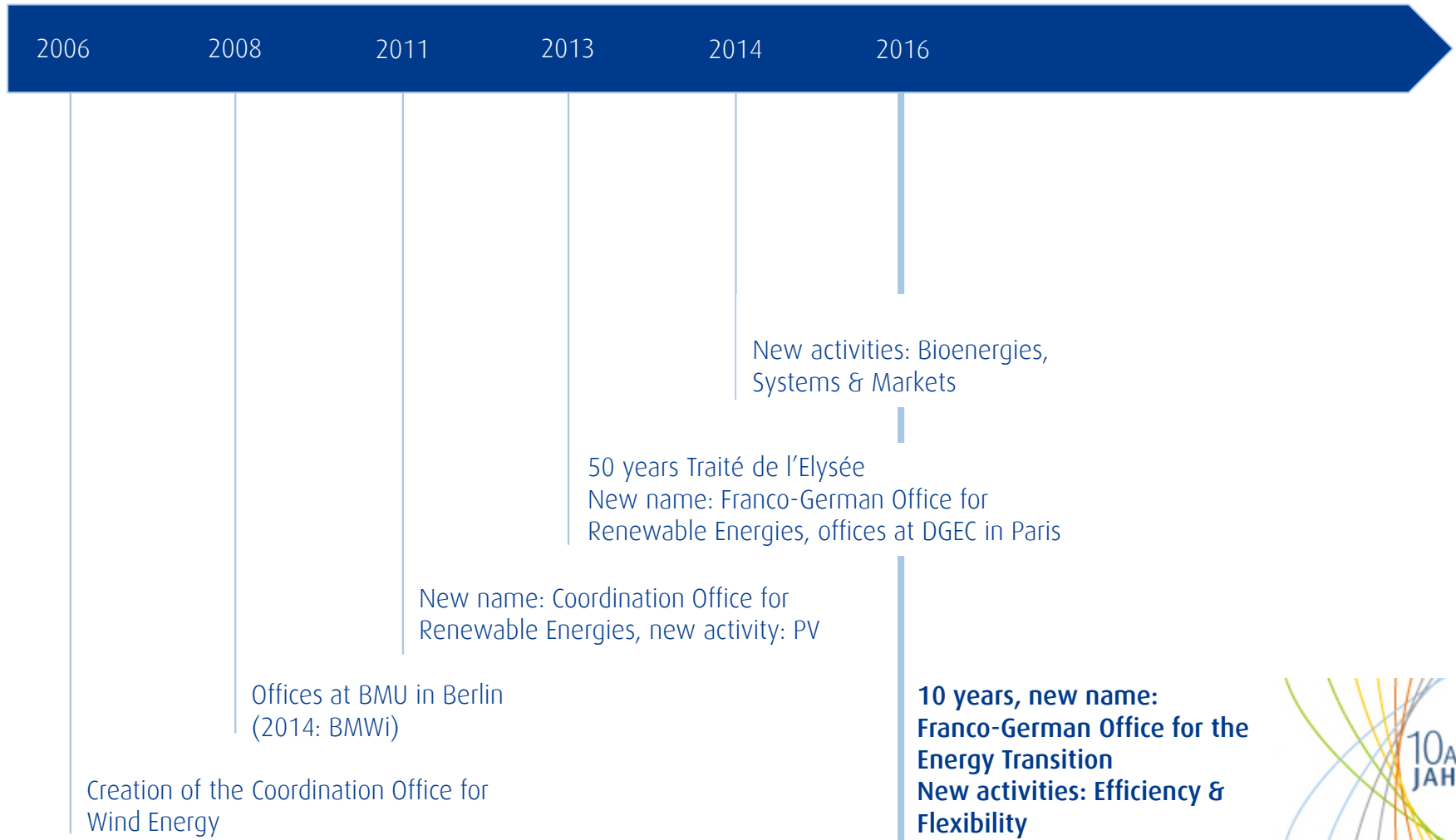

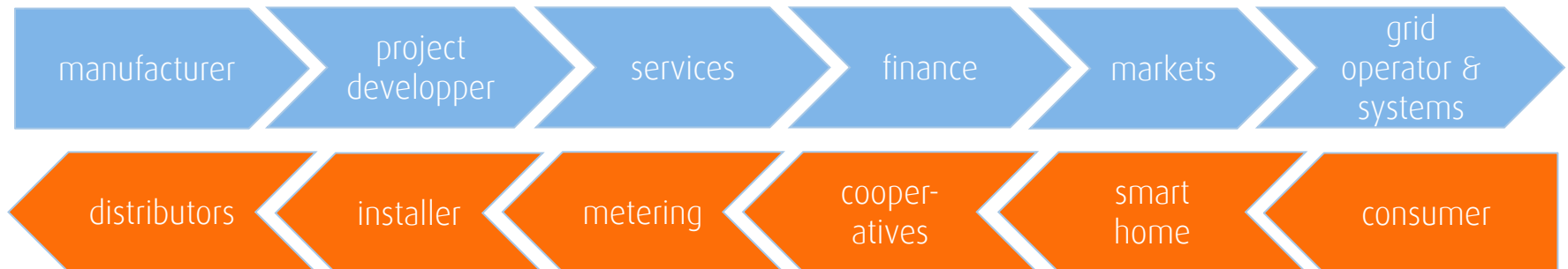

Publishing
